- Training survey results (McKinney)
 - Format – all received high responses
 - Interest in regional meetings on site → need members to help in logistics (finding locations, general coordination/setup)
 - Recording trainings is ideal
 - YouTube via Blog email account
 - Leverage WebEx
 - Topics – Development and web GIS followed by desktop GIS are most popular
 - Some open ended responses for server admin/management
 - Think about trainings for non-GIS folks too
 - Collector with disconnected editing – for members and non-members – possibilities and how-to's
 - Level of technical – moderately technical is highest % (follows industry trends)
 - GIS experience – 11 to 20 years highest
 - Knowledge base – cadastral/parcel, planning/environment, transportation. Several comments on public safety and oil/gas
 - Good webinar topics to pair with technology
 - GISP – 60/40 split toward No....need to ask why
 - Another good potential webinar topic
 - Look at promoting GISP and benefits of being a member and how it relates
 - Values of GISP, how to fill out application, prep for the test
 - Other Benefits PA MAGIC could offer – live regional meetings, members-only knowledge were highest
 - No lobbying identified
 - Trainings that illustrate regional coordination and across multiple levels of government and elated standardization
 - Possibly leverage survey results for PA GIS Conference tracks
 - Summarize results and send out to survey respondents and put on website, Facebook, GIS Forum etc. (Patrick)
